The "CZ" offers two very definite set-ups to aim for: the Zukertort, where the dark-squared bishop is developed to b2; and the Colle, where it stays on the c1 - h6 diagonal.

This is a repertoire book for the White player utilizing the undeservedly less popular Zukertort flavour of the Colle System. In the "CZ" System the c1 (Queen's for the more mature reader !) bishop is developed to b2 rather than the c1 - h6 diagonal as in the Koltanowski flavour of the Colle System.

Stay away from the Colle-Zukertort System where White places the bishop on b2. This is far too complex for you. You have a lot to learn in the simple Colle because Black often does not play the standard theoretical moves, which I show you below, but plays other moves. For example: he plays his queenside bishop to g4 or f5.
