

Linking Words B1 Packaging

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These linking words connect two contrasting ideas and are followed by a clause (pronoun/noun + verb). "But" is normally in the middle of a sentence, preceded by a comma, while "although/though" can go in the middle and at the beginning. "The hotel was excellent, but the food was not good."
