Teach your child to tell you and not wait for you to ask. Young children should tell a parent before they use the bathroom, in case they need help. If your child keeps soiling after about 3 months of being able to use the toilet to urinate, it's time for him or her to learn to work on bowel movements.

Although most children with soiling do not have a physical condition, they should first have a complete physical evaluation by a family physician or pediatrician. If no physical causes are found, or if problems continue, the next step is an evaluation by a child and adolescent psychiatrist.

The intestines may lose their ability to contract, making bowel movements even more of a challenge and fecal soiling more likely. In most cases, the best way to approach the problem of fecal soiling due to constipation is to address the underlying issue that is causing your child to resist having a bowel movement.

Encopresis (or faecal soiling) is one of the most frustrating difficulties of middle childhood, affecting approximately 1.5% of young school children (von Gontard, 2013). It is a debilitating condition to deal with as a parent, as it usually occurs at a stage when children are past the age of toilet training.

In most cases, soiling is a symptom of chronic constipation. Far less frequently it occurs without constipation and may be the result of emotional issues. Encopresis can be frustrating for parents — and embarrassing for the child. However, with patience and positive reinforcement, treatment for encopresis is usually successful.

Identify the problem. Just stating the problem out loud can make a big difference for kids who are feeling stuck. Help your child state the problem, such as, "You don't have anyone to play with at recess," or "You aren't sure if you should take the advanced math class." Develop at least five possible solutions.

How to Teach Kids Problem-Solving Skills

This, as one of the basic soil problems, is common to sandy soils. If your soils dry out too quickly, you can add compost. Role model effective problem solving for your child. Select children's books where the characters encounter a problem. Ask the children how the character in the story could solve their problem. Encourage a variety of solutions.

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
