We distinguish between five main levels in the teaching process of handball. H@S programme primarily develops across the first three levels, novice, beginner and intermediate, and marginally touches the advanced level.

Introduction - International Handball Federation

The United States Handball Association promotes "any ball, any wall" in teaching. Teachers are encouraged to use any available equipment and space. Handball can be taught as a unit for the entire class in the gymnasium or used as a station activity in one section of the gym. There is no need for regulation sized courts in a gymnasium.

TEAM HANDBALL LESSON 1 4th-5th GRADE 2 on 1 Keep Away • • Designate one person to be in the middle (interceptor).
