Crematorium I Crematorium I operated [at Auschwitz] from August 15, 1940 until July 1943. According to calculations by the German authorities, 340 corpses could be burned every 24 hours after the installation of the three furnaces. The largest room in this building was designated as a morgue.

Crematoria & Gas Chambers at Auschwitz-Birkenau

The six ovens were in the main camp known as the Stammlager or Auschwitz I. These six ovens were housed in a crematorium known as Krema I in much of the literature. In the summer of 1942 the Auschwitz Construction Agency, known as the Bauleitung, started to build four new crematoria in the Birkenau area of the camp, also known as Auschwitz II.
